## Nylon Appliance\* Adjustment Instructions

Nylon appliances are easy to adjust. The technique is similar to that of a traditional appliance.





## REMOVING ARTICULATING PAPER MARKS FROM NYLON

(Blue Articulating Paper Strips • 056-015)

- Use the Nylon Abrasive Buff (086-046) on a lab handpiece (10,000-15,000 RPM).
- 2. Apply light pressure in a sweeping motion to gently remove the markings.

### ADDING ACRYLIC

(Fast White Acrylic Kit • 040-004)

- Use a rough-cut bur to roughen the surface where acrylic is needed.
- 2. Apply the acrylic in a "wetter" stage ensure enough monomer is coating the acrylic dough to ensure proper bonding.
- To smooth and shape uncured acrylic: Use gloves; dip your finger in monomer and run it along the surface of the acrylic until it reaches the desired smoothness.
- Cure the acrylic according to manufacturer recommendations.

# ADJUSTING AND SHAPING ADDED ACRYLIC AFTER CURING

- Use a standard carbide acrylic bur to adjust the acrylic.
- 2. Tap down for occlusal contacts if necessary.
- Using sandpaper, adjust and smooth the appliance surface to desired bite.
- 4. Once done adjusting, pumice the appliance on slow speed for smoother finish.
- Polish the appliance using white polish on high speed only.
